

SUMMER SCHOOL: The HCPSS Summer School program is a great opportunity for students to gain credit toward graduation and to further their academic enrichment.

This year summer school will be held at Centennial High School and Oakland Mills High School!

- The program is especially important for those students who failed a course during the school year. It is imperative that students who do not pass a course during the school year enroll in summer school and re-take the course prior to beginning the new school year.
- If there are limitations preventing your child from registering for summer school to re-take a course, please speak to his/her school counselor as soon as possible.

As the school year begins to wind down, please continue communication with your child and their teachers. Many times there is an uncertainty as to whether or not the student will have to re-take a course in summer school, however, with continued communication, you and your student will have a better understanding of how they will finish in their classes.

- If you and your student are unsure as to whether they will pass a class, it is our recommendation that you register your child for the class. If your student passes the class, they can withdraw from the summer school class and you will be given a refund. The request for withdrawal from a class must be given to the summer school principal by July 2nd.
